**243.010 Insurance for members of State Police force and penitentiary guards.** The Oregon State Board of Control shall enter into a contract with an insurance company licensed to do business in Oregon to purchase group insurance on the lives of all eligible members of the Oregon State Police and guards at the Oregon State Penitentiary

**243.020 Issuance of \$5,000 policy.** There shall be issued to every eligible member of the Oregon State Police and every eligible guard at the Oregon State Penitentiary pursuant to the contract provided for in ORS 243.010, a term group life insurance certificate in the face amount of \$5,000 on the life of such employe. The insurance certificate shall set forth the names of any beneficiaries whom the insured may designate

**243.030 Insurance for new police officers and guards.** Any eligible person entering the employ of the Oregon State Police as an active police officer or entering the employ of the Oregon State Penitentiary as a guard after April 30, 1951, shall be insured as other police officers and guards immediately upon taking the oath of office

**243.040 Surrender or conversion on separation.** Every police officer or guard, upon termination of active duty or permanent release, may surrender the certificate to the head of the department or, at his option, may convert the insurance in accordance with the provisions of the contract, and no further premiums shall be paid on the policy by the state.

**243.050 Department contribution to be included in the budget.** The Superintendent of the Oregon State Police and the Warden of the Oregon State Penitentiary shall include in the biennial budget of their respective departments amounts sufficient to pay the annual premiums accruing on policies of insurance, covering police officers and guards, purchased under this chapter

**243.060 Premium payments; payroll deduction.** (1) The premiums on the insurance provided for in this chapter are to be paid one-half by the employe and one-half by the state department affected, with a maximum on the department's contribution of \$1.50 per month for each guard or police officer covered. All additional charges for premiums above the \$1.50 per month to be paid by the department are to be paid by the employe.

(2) The Superintendent of the Oregon State Police and the Warden of the Oregon State Penitentiary may make a monthly deduction on the payroll of the amount due from each employe under subsection (1) of this section and remit the same, with the department's contribution, to the insurance company holding the contract for the insurance.

**243.070 Insurance in lieu of claims against state.** The term group life insurance provided for in this chapter is to be in lieu of any and all claims against the State of Oregon other than claims coming under the jurisdiction of the State Industrial Accident Commission
